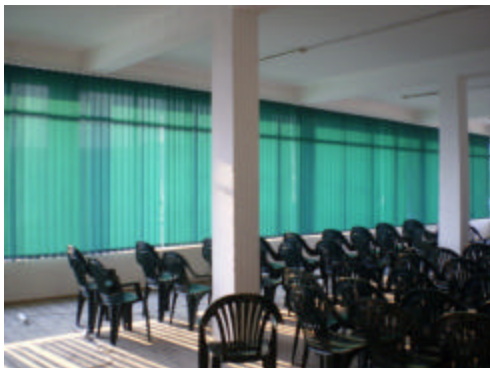
For the first two years of our church's life, we had been renting a meeting facility by the hour. That was putting many limits on us as well as stretching us financially. Not to mention the inconvenience of packing up everything and setting up again for each meeting. But no more!

We have found a place in the most populated part of the city, where one third of Cluj-ites live. It is easily accessible and just across the street from "Cora", a major grocery-department store (the Romanian equivalent of a super Wa-Mart).



The building has direct access from the street, with a primary meeting room of some 2500 sq. ft. and another 400 sq. ft outside terrace. This gives us some growing room for the next phase of our growth and ministry. It is in a stand alone building so there will be no conflict with neighbors! This is a great plus for us! And it opens up countless possibilities for us as a church. Conferences, children's outreaches, worship practice, concerts, etc. We are just thrilled!

The inside needs some renovations to make it fit our purposes. We are adding bathrooms and smaller meeting rooms for children and counseling, etc. We must also install a heating system before the winter arrives. These renovations will cost about \$12,000.



We are also considering starting some small businesses to help cover the costs of renting the building...perhaps a coffee shop, perhaps a day care center. The cogs in our brains are whirling as we consider what is possible. Please do pray for unity and God inspired ideas for bringing the necessary financial resources into the ministry.

Do rejoice with us. We are really excited! Why don't you drop by and see for yourself! ;-) Well wait just a while. I don't know the address yet!
