

Ministry Update

Wow! Three more wonderful days of meetings in Huedin!

God moved so strongly and powerfully. His weighty, tangible presence filled the room and He did what He does best... saved the lost, healed the sick and set the captives free. It was a really amazing experience to be a part of. God got "awesome-er" in my eyes during those days!

Each night there was a good crowd... 30, 50 and 45 people respectively Saturday, Sunday and Monday*** nights, together with our team of 6-8 people. ***Though we were originally



scheduled for Friday, Saturday and Sunday, we got bumped at the last moment because the mayor's office required the use of the facility. So we reprinted our invitations and posters and had one extra day to pray!

The worship was simple but brought the presence of God. David preached each night about being involved in the mission of God as described in Matthew 28 and Mark 16. He also emphasized that God uses imperfect people. The messages combined for a clear and strong encouragement for God's people to get out of inactivity and to get involved in God's work.

But by far my favorite part of the meetings was the ministry time. Every night God gave David and Miha words of knowledge...telling them what conditions, sicknesses, and pains were being healed in the gathering. As God spoke to them, they spoke the conditions out from the microphone. Then we went out into the crowd and began to pray for people. As the prayer continued, these words of knowledge proved to be very accurate....we found people suffering with just what God has told David and Miha. Miracles were numerous. Here are a few of my favorites:

FIRST NIGHT

**One lady suffered a form of paralysis. Her right arm was partially paralyzed and she had no power in her right hand to grasp. In addition, the left side of her face was drawn up into what looked like a permanent spasm high on her cheek bone. As Dima and Ioana prayed for her, her face relaxed and her facial muscles returned to normal. By the end of the prayer she could also strongly squeeze Dima's hand, with her formerly useless right hand!

**An Orthodox lady was there and said she loved our meetings because she "felt God was there in the room". She had three of the conditions that were called out by words of knowledge, a lump on her spine causing pain, pressure in her head, and general body aches. She was all smiles after prayer, feeling significantly better.

**A young lady had pain in her kidneys (also a word of knowledge). I asked her specifically before we began to pray if she was in pain at that moment. She said yes. After Maya and I prayed for her

a few minutes, I asked her to move around and see if her kidneys hurt anymore. Her eyes got real big and she said “I don’t feel anything!” She was thrilled... and so was I!

**A lady walked with a limp all of her life, having one leg noticeably longer than the other. Miha prayed for God to heal her and she felt the strong sensation of tingling in her hip and leg. She tried out her new legs and was shocked to find both legs the same length! No more limp!

**A young gypsy boy gave his life to Christ as he witnessed what God was doing around him.



SECOND NIGHT

**A little Hungarian lady had shooting pains originating at the back of her head and shooting down into her shoulders and arms. As I prayed, she began to tremble. It was evident that God was doing something powerful. She said she felt unusual heat flowing up and down her body. When she began to move and test out her healing, she felt no more pain! Healed!

**Another older woman had problems in her stomach causing her great pain and in her heart too (both words of knowledge from the microphone). I prayed for her and she too felt a tangible touch from God. The pain suddenly left her stomach and she also told me “I can feel that my heart is healed too.” I’m not quite sure what that feels like....but I DO believe God healed her stomach AND heart.

**After God had quickly healed three or four people, it was clear that there was a very strong anointing for healing that night. I remember turning around and asking “Who needs to be healed?” ...not who wants prayer? That was a highlight for me. I felt “super charged” with God’s power and heart for healing. Everyone that we prayed for healing that night was healed! Amazing! David later described it: “Healing was easy. Like a hot knife cutting through butter!” And so it was!

THIRD NIGHT

**Claudia and I prayed for the lady mentioned above that was healed Saturday night of a form of paralysis. This time we prayed for healing of a skin condition (word of knowledge), an inflamed, scabby, eruption on her arm. The power of God came strong and tangible in her body. I have no doubt she was healed, but next time I see her, I expect to “see” her healing.

**There were four Pentecostal ladies, all in a row, sitting stiffly with covered heads. They had arrived during the ministry time as things were gearing down. I offered prayer and one of the ladies grudgingly accepted. As Claudia and I prayed for her, she felt electricity buzzing through her body and she was trembling visibly. She was healed of a long time rheumatic pain in her shoulder. After healing she could move her arm freely with no pain.



**Going to the next Pentecostal lady, she flatly turned me down saying “We know that God doesn’t listen to prayers if your head isn’t covered.” Mine wasn’t. Hers was! So I walked away a bit sad that “religion” blocked a blessing. I noticed in the corner of my eye that the other Pentecostal ladies were continuing to talk to her along with the lady that had been healed of paralysis in her face and hand. A bit later, I noticed the group all looking at me and I could tell something was up. The lady that had refused me before asked me to pray for her too. Then God zapped her good! She looked like she had stuck her finger in a light socket. Vibrating all over and breathing in gasps. She got healed too, quite dramatically.

I’ve told a part what happened, but looking around the room each night, it was evident that God was moving so strongly with every ministry team. Some crying, some rejoicing, some soaking in God’s strong presence, and others in wide-eyed wonder. It was something really amazing and wonderful as we saw God bring heaven to earth. Even as we ministered we enjoyed watching God do His thing. We witnessed a truly special display of God’s glory as God paraded His goodness before us.

So next Sunday church in Huedin continues “as usual”. We fully expect that God will continue winning hearts as He heals broken bodies and hearts. Thanks so much for praying for us in this adventure. I can’t express how thankful we are that you stand with us.
